


Description: DCT Series - Surface Installation Instructions

IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS


- This product must be installed in accordance with all applicable installation codes by a person familiar with the construction and operation of the product and the hazards involved.





INSTALLATION STEPS

1. Remove Housing Screws to release Back Plate (Fig. 1)
2. Mount Back Plate on the junction box to the wall with Mounting Hardware (provided by others) (Fig. 2).
3. Make all necessary electrical connections, and slide Housing onto Back Plate (Fig. 3)
4. Fasten Housing to Back Plate with Housing Screws. Use pick caulk around top and sides of Housing. Do not use pick caulk along bottom (Fig. 4)
